Child of God, you need to be assured that when you were saved and brought into the family of God, you were also clothed, robed, and dressed for success with the blessing: **The blessing of God is the equipment, the substance, the robe that God dresses or clothes us with so that we can achieve success and prosperity in this life.** I am talking about that heavenly, intangible "ointment" that God paints, rubs, and smears on all of His children to allow us to fulfill our God-given destinies in this life.

When the blessing is on you it will make, produce, and provide the necessary resources to bring you to a place of abundant supply and overflowing success. God knows that apart from Him and His blessing you cannot make it in this life. In fact, Jesus said that "apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5). How does a Christian do that?

- By obedience (Colossians 3:22; Job 36:11; Isaiah 1:19)
- By faith (Romans 5:2; 2 Corinthians 5:7)
- By confessing it upon yourself (Romans 10:9-10; Mark 11:24)
